Words of Wisdom

The Liturgy of St. James (St. James Liturgy) By Philipachen

The Liturgy of St. James the Just serves as the foundational liturgy for all Malankara Syrian Christian Churches of Eastern origin.

St. James, who became the Bishop of Jerusalem soon after the formation of the Church at Pentecost, was the brother of Jesus. While he was not a believer during Jesus' lifetime, he encountered Jesus after the resurrection. Recognized as a scholar of Scripture, he was esteemed as a rational and righteous man under the law.

Over time, the Liturgy of St. James has evolved to adapt to changing contexts, although its fundamental structure has remained intact. The liturgy reflects St. James's understanding of the majesty of God, his brother, and serves a dual purpose:

Worship Experience: It transports worshippers from the mundane world into a spiritual dimension, allowing them to worship "in spirit and truth."

Message of Salvation: It conveys the message of salvation through various human senses, enriching the worship experience.

As one of the oldest liturgies still in use, the Liturgy of St. James remains celebrated in Jerusalem, particularly on St. James's Day, and is observed by all churches of Byzantine tradition. In Malankara (Kerala), it is practiced in all Syrian and Malankara Orthodox Churches, except the Chalcedonian Orthodox. Additionally, it served as the basis for the liturgy of the Scottish

PEpiscopal Church in England and influenced the charismatic services of the Catholic Apostolic Church (Irvingites) in the 19th century.

Evolution and Modern Influences

The liturgy has undergone significant modifications throughout history, largely in response to modernism. These changes are particularly evident in the first part of the service, known as the ministry of the word. This segment evolved to address heresies that arose within the Church, ultimately leading to the establishment of the Nicene Creed as a defining statement of faith. Variations are also discernible across different churches in Malankara

auditory elements, such as the ringing of bells. This change corresponds to the theological principles of the Reformation, which repudiated the

doctrine of transubstantiation—the belief that bread and wine become the actual body and blood of Christ during communion. The loud bells d

and exuberant praise traditionally accompanying the priest's presentation of the elements could lead the congregation to misunderstand the nature of this sacred act, bordering on idol worship.

To counter this, the church eliminated phrases like I carry the body and blood of Christ" and the accompanying ceremonial sounds. The Evangelical Church has taken this further by removing the veil and the holy of holies, positioning the altar table among the people. This shift emphasizes the concept of the incarnation as God's physical presence among His people, echoing the significance of the tent temple in the desert. Consequently, much of the liturgical pageantry has diminished, with the focus shifting from worship to a memorial of the Last Supper.
